FORM #1524 FINE ADJUSTABLE OUTRIGGERS

Installation/Setup

The adjustable outriggers may be installed to any sawmill with 24' frame (optional on LT28/35/40/50; standard on LT70). Assemble the adjustable outrigger assemblies to the sawmill frame where the existing outriggers or stationary feet are mounted:

- 1. If necessary, move the saw head to the travel location.
- 2. Lower the second front-most outrigger and use the jack handle to adjust the outrigger to support the weight of the sawmill frame.
- 3. Remove the front-most outrigger (closest to hitch).
- **4.** Reuse the outrigger mounting hardware to install the front adjustable outrigger to the sawmill frame.
- Disengage the locking pin retainer on the front adjustable outrigger.
- **6.** Hold the adjustable leg with one hand and pull out the locking pin.
- 7. Lower the adjustable leg to align the locking pin holes so the foot pad is as close to the ground as possible.
- 8. Reinstall the locking pin and secure with the retainer...
- **9.** Use the provided crank handle to turn the outrigger adjustment nut counterclockwise to push the foot pad down to support the weight of the sawmill frame.
- **10.** Remove the next two front outriggers and install a loading-side adjustable outrigger and offset adjustable outrigger to the sawmill frame at these two locations.
- 11. Again, reuse the mounting hardware to install the adjustable outriggers.
- **12.** For the loading-side outrigger, use the provided square nuts to replace the original flat washers and hex nuts.




- 13. Repeat the step above to install offset and loading-side adjustable outriggers at the rear of the sawmill frame.
- **14.** Remove the rear outrigger and install the rear adjustable outrigger assembly, reusing the mounting hardware.


Operation



WARNING! Do not set up the mill on ground with more than a 10 degree incline. If setup on an incline is necessary, put blocks under one side of the mill or dig out areas for outrigger legs to keep mill level. Setting up the mill on an incline could cause it to tip over, resulting in serious personal injury.

WARNING! Chock the trailer wheels to prevent movement before unhitching it from the towing vehicle. Failure to do so may result in serious injury or death.

WARNING! Always make sure the trailer is supporting the sawmill frame when operating a sawmill

with adjustable outriggers. Failure to do so may result in serious injury or death. The adjustable outriggers are intended to support the saw frame with assistance from the trailer.

WARNING! The adjustable outriggers supplied with portable sawmills are not intended for setup on concrete or other hard surfaces. Long-term use of the adjustable outriggers on hard surfaces may cause the outriggers to fail, causing the sawmill to drop. This could result in possible serious injury or death.

If setting the sawmill up on concrete or other hard surface, replace the adjustable outrigger legs with stationary legs.

To set outriggers for sawing:

1. With the saw head in the travel position, set the front outrigger as described on setup section.



WARNING! Put front outrigger down before moving cutting head from the rest position. Failure to do so may result in serious injury.


- 2. Move the saw head to the front of the sawmill and adjust the rear outriggers.
- 3. Rear outrigger adjustment is similar to the front outrigger.
- **4.** Remove the locking pin and adjust the leg down.
- 5. Replace the locking pin and use the crank to adjust the outrigger as desired.

To set outriggers for towing:

- 1. With the saw head at the front of the sawmill, use the crank handle to turn the rear outrigger adjustment nut clockwise until the outrigger does not bear weight.
- 2. Disengage the locking pin retainer and remove the locking pin.
- 3. Raise the leg all the way up so the bottom-most hole is aligned with the locking pin hole.
- **4.** Replace the locking pin and secure with the retainer. Repeat for the other rear outriggers.
- 5. Move the saw head to the travel position and raise the front outriggers as described above.
- **6.** Connect the hitch to the towing vehicle and raise the front-most outrigger.

Maintenance


Grease the Fine Adjust Outriggers (FAOs) every 200 hours of operation or once a month, whichever comes first. Use one squeeze of a NLGI No. 2 grade lithium grease from a grease gun to lubricate the outrigger and remove any sawdust.




